Charter Communications

Comcast

Comcast announced it is offering low-income households who qualify and don't currently have internet service the opportunity to sign up and receive complimentary service for 60 days. The service is part of changes to the company's Internet Essentials program, which normally gives low-income families internet access at reduced prices of \$9.95/month.
